

Directions to downloading the God in the Storm e-Book on all devices:

Apple iPad:

- Click on the link from our website on your Apple iPad.
- Use the File Upload button – select “Share File via” option.
- Choose your reading app – iBooks (Apple Books) or Kindle (it’s best to have the app already downloaded first) - choose “open in” if your app doesn’t immediately appear (then use ellipsis for all options)
- You can also select the icon “Copy to Books”
- Please note – *there is also an option that may pop up to purchase the book for \$7.99 – do not choose that one. Ours is a free download.*

Nook Tablet:

- Download ePub file to PC or Mac device.
- Connect tablet to phone, PC, or Mac device.
- Open file manager on your device.
- Open Nook folder.
- Drag (or copy) ePub file to Nook folder.
- Disconnect Nook device.
- Locate ePub in “My Files” on Nook tablet. Open & Read.

Kindle with WiFi or Kindle App on a WiFi Android device:

- If running the Kindle app on the same device as used to download the mobi file, simply click to download the mobi document.
- Locate the mobi document in File Manager (or associated app) and open. The Kindle app will recognize the mobi file extension as a readable file and may ask for confirmation that you wish to send this to your Kindle.

Kindle without WiFi or Kindle Sync:

- If running the Kindle app on a device not accessible to the downloadable mobi file, OR if you wish to sync the file across devices, you should use your Send-to-Kindle e-mail address to send the document. The Send-to-Kindle e-mail address associated with your device can be found in your “Manage your Devices” page in your Amazon account under “Manage Your Kindle”. If you need to add an e-mail account, use the “Personal Document Settings” page under “Manage Your Kindle”.
- It may be necessary to approve the mobi document type under the “Approved Personal Document E-mail List”.
- To send the document to the Kindle device (or app for syncing), attach the mobi file in an e-mail addressed to your Send-to-Kindle e-mail. Note: no subject line is necessary in the e-mail.
- Locate the mobi document in the Kindle app (under documents) or on the Kindle device. It may take a few minutes for the sent document to appear in the documents library. Open & Read.
