MEMORY VERSE:

"I am alive for ever and ever!" Revelation 1:18

KEY QUESTION AND BOTTOM LINE:

Who is alive?
Jesus is alive!

BIBLE STORY & SONG

WHAT YOU NEED: [link to today's lesson](#)

ACTIVITY: LET'S CHEER!

WHAT YOU NEED: Enthusiasm 😊

WHAT YOU SAY: "Let's say a cheer! When I say, 'who is alive?' I want you to wave your hands in the air, and loudly say, 'Jesus is alive!' You can jump and you can wave your hands in the air. Are you ready? Who is alive?" (Say with kids) "Jesus is alive!" Continue as long as interest and time allows.

ACTIVITY: BEAN BAG TOSS/BALL ROLL

WHAT YOU NEED: Bean bag, small ball, or car/truck

WHAT YOU SAY: "Let's sit in a circle. We are going to gently toss this bean bag (OR We are going to roll this ball or car/truck) to each other around the circle."

AFTER ACTIVITY: "That was so fun! Is tossing a bean bag or rolling a ball/car more fun alone or more fun with someone else? (Pause.) Yes! It's way more fun to play with a friend! Today's Bible story is about Jesus spending time with His friends at the beach after he died and came back alive again!"



ACTIVITY: STORY RETELL

"Our Bible story today was about some men who were in a boat fishing. Who did they see on the beach while they were in the boat fishing? (Pause.)

"Yes! They saw Jesus! And what did Jesus do for His friends when they hurried to see Him? (Pause.) Right again! Jesus made them breakfast on the beach. Jesus wanted His friends to see that He is alive and He wants to be their friend forever."

"We are learning a Bible verse that will help us remember that Jesus is alive. So, tell me: who is alive?"

Family all together: "Jesus is alive!"

MEMORY VERSE: (Use the pictures below for motions.) "Did you know that Jesus wants us to remember that He is alive, forever!"

PRAYER: "Dear God, we are so thankful Jesus is alive and He loves us and He wants to be our friend for ever and ever. Thank you that we can be with Jesus everywhere we go. Thank you that we can spend time with Jesus wherever we are. You are the best, God, and we love You. In Jesus' name, amen."
