FAMILY CONNECT QUESTION:

What is one thing you are thankful for?

In today's Bible Story, we heard about a time when all the people who trust God will sing a song to tell Him how thankful they are.

ACTIVITY: Thankful Hands

What you need: paper, marker or crayons

Trace your hand on a piece of paper with a marker or crayon. Draw or write something you are thankful for in each of the fingers as follows:

A person you are thankful for A place you are thankful for A think you are thankful for A skill you are thankful for A feeling you are thankful for

Say: We have so much to be thankful for, don't we? There is nothing greater we have to be thankful for than Jesus.

ACTIVITY: BIBLE STORY RETELL

Isaiah the prophet told God's message to the people of Judah. He told them about a time in the future – the Day of the Lord – when God will judge the earth and bless His people.

What will that day be like? Isaiah said that it will be a happy day! God will rescue His people from sin. God's people will sing and thank Him.

Isaiah said, "On that day, you will say: 'I will praise You, Lord! You were angry with me, but You did not stay angry. You have comforted me. Yes, God is the One who saves me. I will trust Him and not be afraid. The Lord gives me strength and keeps me safe.'''

"God will save His people, and you will have joy. You will sing, 'Praise the Lord! Make His name famous! Tell everyone what he has done. Sing to the Lord. He has done glorious things. Tell everyone in the world about Him. People of Zion, shout and sing! The Holy One of Israel is with you, and He is great!""

Pray:

God, we have so many things to thank You for. Sometimes we forget what an incredible gift Your son, Jesus, is to us. He died and rose again to save us from our sins. Help us to never forget this amazing gift and to help us share this gift with others. In Jesus' name, amen.
