ACTIVITY: SIMON SAYS

WHAT YOU SAY: "In our true Bible story today, we learned that Jesus wants everyone to believe in Him. He wants them to know that He loves them and He wants to be their friend forever. Jesus wants us to do what He asks us to do, and that is to tell everyone, everywhere, that Jesus loves them and wants to be their friend forever.

Let's play a game of Simon Says. When I say, 'Simon says to jump', I want you to jump. I'll tell you to do some different movements. You will have to listen carefully to hear what I say, just like we need to listen carefully to Jesus, so we can do what He tells us to do." (Play the game, choosing your own movements. Take turns being 'Simon'.)

ACTIVITY: STORY RETELL

Our true Bible story today, was about a man named Peter. Peter learned that Jesus loves everyone, and He wants to be everyone's friend forever. It doesn't matter where people live, what they look like, what language they speak, or what their favorite food is; Jesus loves everyone and wants to be their friend! We can read Peter's story in the Bible. Peter's story helps us know that we can believe in Jesus, too, because Jesus loves everyone and wants to be everyone's friend.

Tell me: "Who can believe in Jesus?"

Family all together: "I can believe in Jesus!"

MEMORY VERSE: "The Bible verse we have been learning even says that the stories in the Bible are written so that we can believe in Jesus." (Use the pictures below for the verse and motions.)

PRAYER: "Dear God, we want everyone to believe in Jesus. We want everyone to know that Jesus wants to be their friend forever. Help us to tell our neighbors, our friends, and our family that Jesus is alive, and He wants to be their friend forever. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."
