ACTIVITY: FREEZE DANCE

WHAT YOU NEED: music from the video, DCC PreK Kids Spotify play list, or any favorite worship song.

WHAT YOU DO: Dance around while music is playing, stop music and have children freeze and say, "I can believe in Jesus!" Start music again. Repeat at various times throughout the song.

WHAT YOU SAY: "While the music is playing let's all dance. Each time the music stops, we all have to say, 'I can believe in Jesus.' Then I'll start the music again. Let's dance!"



ACTIVITY: STORY RETELL

WHAT YOU SAY: Our true Bible story, today, was about a man named Paul who loved Jesus. Paul traveled to a city called Rome so he could tell the people about Jesus. He told them that everything Jesus says is the truth, because Jesus always tells the truth. We can read Paul's story in the Bible. Paul wrote down what he knew about Jesus so we could read it and believe in Jesus, too.

Tell me: "Who can believe in Jesus?"

Family all together: "I can believe in Jesus!"

MEMORY VERSE: "All of the stories in the Bible were written to help us believe in Jesus. Let's verse together with the motions." (Use the pictures below for verse and motions.)

PRAYER: "Dear God, it is so wonderful to know that we can believe in Jesus and everything He said, because everything Jesus said is true. Because Jesus said it, we believe that Jesus is God's Son. Jesus loves everyone. Jesus wants us to follow Him. Jesus wants us to love people the way He loves us. Jesus will always be with us. Jesus will hear us when we talk to Him. Jesus wants all children to come to Him. I pray we will always believe in Jesus and what He said. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."
